Computer & Internet Code of Behaviour



Rights

- 1. I have the right to use the school computer network and internet facilities for classroom assignments.
- 2. I have the right to privacy for my password and my work, however, I understand that staff will supervise me to ensure that I am on task.
- 3. I have the right to use a workstation that is well maintained and not vandalised.
- 4. I have the right to use school approved portable media.
- 5. I have the right to be safe and not confronted by rude, obscene or dangerous material.

Responsibilities

- 1. I have the responsibility to maintain the computer facilities as the school community has set them up for use.
- 2. I have the responsibility to report any problems with hardware or set up immediately to a teacher / supervisor.
- 3. I have the responsibility to respect the privacy of other people's passwords and under no conditions reveal my password to other students.
- 4. I have the responsibility to observe all copyright laws in my use of software and the internet. I will avoid plagiarism and acknowledge all sources.
- 5. I have the responsibility to use appropriate language (netiquette).
- 6. I have the responsibility to report any sites containing offensive or inappropriate material.
- 7. I have the responsibility to ensure my own personal safety and that of others by not revealing the personal details of myself or any other person on the internet.
- 8. I have the responsibility to ensure that I use the computers appropriately and I will not congregate around workstations that are used by other students.

Consequences

Breaches of the Code of Behaviour will result in the loss of privileges, including access to the School Computer Network and Internet. Other actions may be required as specified in the School's Code of Conduct.
