IMPORTANT:

- These rehearsals are for **practice only**. Marks will not count towards any HSC assessment.
- Exam papers used in rehearsals will **not be used in class**, or handed out at other times. The only time they will be used is in the rehearsals.
- Attendance is **voluntary, but strongly advised!** Please let your class teachers know which rehearsals you will be attending, so we can have the right number of papers printed.
- Some sessions will have **more than one course that you do**. You will need to choose which course-rehearsal you will attend.
- When you attend, you need to be **on time** (1pm start, each time), or you may not be allowed in. As in the actual HSC, you will need to follow all exam conditions.
- All rehearsals will take place in the **listed venue**. If there are any changes, you will be notified (so check your emails!).
