- Some course-rehearsals run more than once. Make sure you attend the one with **your teacher's name**, or you could have a clash.
- If you attend, you need to be **on time** (either 1pm or 2pm start), and **there for the whole rehearsal time**, or your work cannot be marked. As in the actual HSC, you will need to follow all exam conditions, or you may be asked to leave.
- All rehearsals will take place in the **listed venues**. If there is a change in venues, you will be notified (so check your emails!).
